- **Commitment to Cleanliness and Safety** – Our standard cleaning and sterilization procedures have always used EPA-certified cleansers and disinfectants to maintain the cleanliness of our offices and equipment. We practice universal precautions far beyond what the requirements for the virus are calling for. We will continue to be diligent in maintaining universal precautions. - **Emergency Care Will Always be Available** - Even if we are forced to discontinue providing routine care for a period of time we will always be available to address emergencies. A plan is in place to provide emergency care both in-person and via telemedicine.
